### I CALL TO ORDER

### II MINUTES

Presented are corrections to the Minutes from BOD Meeting 11/11/2008:

Howard Braton's name was misspelled (e.g. Branton) in the roll call portion of the last meeting minutes.

*12.09.08.a Motion to accept the corrected minutes from the 11/11/2008 BOD meeting as stated. Motion seconded and passed*

### III PRESIDENT REPORT

Gary Ames and Howard Braton were excused. Potluck coming up.

### IV MEMBERS FORUM

Fred Hamblin reported he saw a member conducting classes at the AGC without BOD approval.

Pete Benoit wished to thank Kimberly for the work she did on the membership renewals, stating he felt the 2009 renewal was the smoothest he could remember. Pete also wanted all to know he would not hold any CMP classes or matches for 2009 at the AGC. Further, he would not be submitting the paperwork to renew the AGC affiliation with the CMP for 2009.

Dean Ames wanted the BOD to make sure that it followed the bylaws of the club. As a public company the members elect the Board of Directors to run the club as the membership sees fit. The BOD is not a monarchy and should follow the bylaws and run the club with the membership always in mind. Dean feels there have been infractions and wishes the BOD to follow the bylaws more closely. Examples of infractions to the bylaws are the lack of quarterly membership meetings and lack of annual audits.

Al Smith wanted suggestions as to how to make running the cash register in the clubhouse easier or more efficient in an effort to make at least the clubhouse accounting easier.

Randy wanted to know if June 13<sup>th</sup> was OK for the tractor show / potluck.
