Our Fixed income account balance is \$278,589.64. Our Alternative Assets balance is \$317,192.14.

Maintenance - AGC 2nd VP, John Price - The door on the Education Trailer at the wheelchair entrance was changed so that it opened to allow anyone in a wheelchair the ability to enter. I have received bids on replacing the roofs on the sheds. I am working on putting shades over berms 6 & 7. I have several projects lined up that I cannot do until the weather gets nicer.
