AGC BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES 3/8/2016

Meeting called to order at 7 PM by President Emmanuel Boyd.

IV. MEMBERS FORUM

AGC Member, Bob Smith - I was looking on our website and I noticed a lot of things that are incorrect. We need to make changes and bring it up to date.

AGC CRO, Terry Humbargar - I had a member ask me to bring a question to the board about bringing back hand traps. AGC President, Emmanuel Boyd stated that due to past incidents, hand traps of any nature are not allowed.

3.8.16.c The board reaffirms the rule TR3 which states "No shooter-owned traps are allowed."

V. OLD BUSINESS

Financial Report — AGC Treasurer, Tom Desmond - In February our revenues were \$16,031.82 and our expenses were \$23,610.49 leaving a negative net change of \$7,578.67. Our YTD revenue is \$33,020.55 and our YTD expenses are \$41,986.28 leaving a negative year to date change of \$8,965.73. Our account balances: Checking Account \$117,507.00; Payroll Account \$41,637.22; and Savings Account \$417,268.72. Our assets with the JP Morgan Cash Holdings account is \$49,419.17. Our Fixed income account balance is \$271,007.49. Our Alternative Assets balance is \$203,321.55. Total JP Morgan is \$523,748.21.

Maintenance — 2nd VP, John Price — I purchased a new high speed modem for the clubhouse. A prone firing line was installed to the east of the benches on the 200 yard range. This will allow prone and bench shooters to shoot simultaneously. Over time a number of vehicles have not stopped on west bound Alameda at Gun Club Road resulting in damage to our barb wire fence. I have contacted the proper agency and requested that they put up a guard rail to prevent cars from coming through our fence. I should get an answer to this in a couple of weeks. The DVR on the caretakers house is about twelve years old. I've checked into replacing it with a system that would allow us to monitor the gate from offsite. The cost of the new system is \$700.00.
