Our Fixed income account balance is \$303,615.45. Our Alternative Assets balance is \$198,114.29. Total JP Morgan is \$540,989.80.

Maintenance — 2nd VP, John Price — We have done a lot of rewiring around the caretakers house and garage. We rehung gutters around the house as well as around the clubhouse on the east and south side. Posts have been replaced on the 100, 200 and magnum ranges. We still have some work to get done between the creek bed to the 200 yard line. If anyone would like to help and/or needs to complete some work hours, please contact me and I can coordinate a schedule.

Website Update — AGC Treasurer, Tom Desmond — We are ready to transition to the new web design. We will be asking for feedback from members and discipline chairmen and to also provide new photos. There will be no videos at this time.

## CMP GARAND/SPRINGFIELD/VINTAGE MATCH

Our final CMP GSM 100 yard match of the season was held on August 13 under perfect conditions. A total of 8 riflemen turned out for the event. As we have seen over the course of the year, scores continue to climb and our average for this match was 261-4x – and improvement of 17 points and 2x over the course of the summer! Rob Spurrier completed his dominating season with a CMP Gold score of 286-5x to win the match. Non-member, but regular CMP rifleman Scott Turnage finished second with a CMP Bronze score of 268-2X, besting another CMP regular Ralph Mishler (267-1x). Rounding out the Bronze Medal finishers were Rob Rathburn (265-4x) and Doug Ruegg (263-4x). Unlike earlier matches where participants used M1 Garands, Springfield '03-A3's, and M1 Carbines, this entire field shouldered M1 Garands.

As we close our season, there are some thanks in order:

To everyone who competed this year. Our largest match numbered 17 participants, and the ranks of CMP shooters continues to grow. We have had the opportunity to stand on the line with a great group of riflemen (including Olympian hopefuls), and we have pushed each other to higher scores. If you haven't tried CMP, this is the primary reason to do so – this is a solid group of people who like to compete, but are willing to help any and all improve their skills and gain an appreciation for these historic firearms.

Thanks also to the AGC Board for supporting our discipline during 2016. The commissioning of the new CMP storage locker in the 100 yard shed is greatly appreciated and a tremendous improvement. It certainly beats lugging all of the consumables and props to and from the Club for every match! A special thanks to the individual(s) (Scott!) directly responsible for the construction carried out during a work party this year. Finally, thanks to Rob Rathburn (Rob I) and Rob Spurrier (Rob II) for their tireless support and assistance in assuring these matches are conducted safely and successfully.

This concludes our 200 yard matches for 2016. Where did the year go? We will use the same format for 2017 and will publish the match dates in an upcoming newsletter. Fun, low key, non-sanctioned matches designed to improve your position shooting skills and get that old rifle out of your safe and on the firing line where it belongs. A great opportunity to shoot your M1A, M1, AR, Enfield, Springfield etc. Any rifle issued by the U.S. Armed forces (or civilian equivalent) or any rifle issued by the Armed forces of a country other than the United States is eligible. Two classes of competition: Tactical Class for those rifles using aperture, ladder or open sights and T-Class for those rifles equipped with telescopic or optical sight. 35 round course of fire. 5 sighting shots in 5 minutes, 10 rounds for record fired from prone in 10 minutes. 10 rounds rapid fire from prone with a mandatory reload in a time limit of 80 seconds and 10 rounds for record fired from offhand (standing) position in 10 minutes.
