## BOARD MEETING MINUTES 9/14/2021

Meeting called to order at 7pm by President Tom Desmond

### IV. MEMBERS FORUM

Tom Desmond – Tom introduced the new clubhouse manager, Faith Gillard at the meeting and welcomed her to the club.

### V. OLD BUSINESS

Financial Report — Treasurer, Loren Kohler - August revenues were \$19,720 and our expenses were \$38,336 leaving a net loss of (\$18,616). Our YTD revenue is \$146,745 and our YTD expenses are \$201,396 leaving a loss of (\$54,651). Account balances: Chase Checking Account \$53,836; Chase Payroll Account \$7,549 and Chase Savings Account \$102,000; Bank of the West Money market account \$308,507; Edward Jones CD – closed. Bank of the West CD - closed; Chase Bank CD \$201,915. Loren provided a detailed analysis of the YTD figures for 2021 compared to 2020.

Workers' Comp Letter — Treasurer, Loren Kohler – The club received a letter from the department of labor regarding an unemployment claim for last year. Loren sent a letter back to the DOL explaining that the employee was paid during the time the unemployment was requested and should not have received unemployment benefits. The claim was paid by the DOL without penalty to the club and the matter is closed.

Maintenance Update – 2<sup>nd</sup> VP of Maintenance, David Faingold – David said he is gearing up for the upcoming work party on 9/25 and has a front loader coming out on 9/23.

Clubhouse Renovation Status – Clubhouse Contractor – The contractor spoke at the meeting and explained that the plans are complete, and he is waiting on the final approval from the city. Certain finishes and other items were delayed due to the red lines from the city and bringing everything up to code such as the ADA requirements for the bathrooms and floor slope. Dietrich asked about the club being a private entity and the contractor explained that every code must comply with the jurisdiction of the property and that commercial jobs do need to comply also. The contractor also expressed to the board that he should have waited to demo the clubhouse until all the permits were received from the city and this would have allowed the club to utilize the clubhouse for a few months longer rather than sitting in a demoed state.

Rules Committee/Review of Proposed Rule Changes – President, Tom Desmond – The Rules Committee met at the club on Saturday, August 14<sup>th</sup>. The committee consisted of Chris Baker, Tom Desmond, and Manny Boyd. Discussion of proposed rules. ~~Strikethrough is removal~~ and underlined is added. Unquoted plain text is additional background on the proposed change. The following changes were proposed:

#### CMP Match (non-sanctioned)

Aurora Gun Club will be holding 60-round (+ 5 minute unlimited sighters) CMP .22 Rimfire Sporter Matches on SATURDAY, October 9, November 13, December 11, January 8 and February 12. (Second Saturday of the month) Sign-in starts at 09:00, shooting begins at 09:30 on the 100 yard rifle range. Match fees are \$5 for AGC Members and \$10 for non-members (this covers range fees and targets).

These matches are "non-sanctioned" (scores will not be reported to the CMP), but the match will be run in accordance with the CMP rules (we won't be sticklers on the rifles used, but match standings will be based on those using rifles that conform to the CMP rules). Additional information can be found at <https://thecmp.org/>.

Match consists of 5-minute unlimited sighting shots followed by 10 rounds prone slow and 2 rapid fire strings of 5 rounds in 25 seconds for semi-autos, 30 for bolt guns at 50 yds. Then repeat the sequence in seated position and Offhand. Offhand is at 25 yds. New shooters are welcome and encouraged.

Finally --- we will remain optimistic with regard to weather. However, if the temperature is below 40 F or if there is or has been precipitation at 09:00 on the day of the match, the match will be cancelled.
