CRO's Corner

I want to personally wish all AGC members a wonderful month. We are most fortunate to live in this state and be able to enjoy the freedoms we do as Americans. This month please take some time to ensure you really are practicing safe shooting. Catalogue your ammunition in any way you feel best (color coded, box shape, labels etc.) so that you know and I say again KNOW what caliber ammunition you take to the range to suite the firearm/s you will be using. Using the wrong caliber ammunition in any firearm could be deadly! If you reload your ammunition, please reload very carefully make sure of your components and usage amounts. Never smoke or drink while reloading and don't get distracted stay with the task at hand. It is far too easy to make a potentially deadly mistake reloading. When at the range please wear eye and ear protection. If you have older safety equipment you might look into a refresh of hearing and eye protection. Technology has advanced over the years the new polycarbonate lenses such as the ESS brand can literally stop a .22 rifle round or shot gun blast! The newer ear muffs are convenient and very effective allowing good hearing protection while not being as bulky as older models. Please ensure all firearms are in good condition prior to heading to the range. Firearms should be cleaned, properly lubricated and function checked (while unloaded) prior to use. All these tasks do take some time I will grant you that. However, they are simple and can easily be made into habits. I like to use the following example. We are shooters not bowlers. In bowling a mistake made might result in embarrassment or perhaps a sore toe, in shooting a mistake could result in death. Have an enjoyable month hopefully punctuated with a few good days at the range.
